message from the pastor

Dear church,

This month we step fully into the Easter season as we celebrated the Resurrection of Our Lord on Sunday, March 31st. On Easter, we heard the Easter text from Mark's gospel which may not be the story as you remember. Mark's account of Easter morning leaves a lot up to the imagination. In Mark's version, there is no encounter between Jesus and Mary or the other disciples and it ends with "They said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid." The reality of these differences in the story, not just the Easter story, may lead to some natural questions. Which of the gospels has the "correct" details? Which one is a complete account? The short answer would be all four of them.

The gospels are written by disciples who lived when Jesus did and experienced a lot of the same things but as different people, they recall and interact with the world in different ways. They are all telling the same story from their own perspective. The writers also tend to have a particular intention behind their writing based on the context they are living in and how they feel moved to testify to who Jesus is and what it means for the audience they are writing to. The gospel writers offer a wonderful example of how the gospel that brings good news for all people, needs to be shared by all people. We each connect and interpret the world in a variety of different ways so why wouldn't the story of Jesus need to be told in a variety of ways?

Each of these gospel accounts give us a variety of ways to learn about who Jesus is and to build our own connection with Christ. As we adventure in this Easter season, what parts of Jesus' story resonate with you? Which gospels do you tend to be drawn into? What parts do you feel particularly called to share? How has God impacted you in your life? How might you share God's story today? How might you share it tomorrow? How might God be at work in your life right now?

It is evident this story is worth sharing because it is for all people. Mark reminds us that how we share the story is up to our imagination. So, let's imagine, shall we? And then let us share.
